Then I'll travel to Siret (near the Ukraine border) and meet up with a Missions Team from Pacific Hills Christian School. I'm really looking forward to seeing some familiar Aussie faces, and hope that it will be a mutually encouraging time. I hope to be back in Kiev in time for lessons on Tuesday morning.

Flat Mates :-

Alyosha and Kolya who have been living out the back of my place have shifted into the house with me. This means there is someone living here while I'm in Kiev. It will also be great for my Ukrainian practice on weekends. Pray that it's a good relationship. I'm charging them only a fraction of what it costs as I live a more expensive standard of living than the average person in Razhishiv. They are both keen and growing Christians and reliable guys.
