Romania



I'm writing this RPD sitting in a café in Chernivtski, southwest Ukraine. I've just spent an amazing 3 days in Romania and am waiting to catch the overnight train back to Kiev. I met up with a mission team from Pacific Hills Christian School. Was great to see them and catch up on a lot of happenings in Australia.

Amelia

I feel that the most impacting thing in the last few days is the story of a girl I've never even met. Firstly meet the Marianciuc Family. (photo) I was staying with this family in Romania. They have 11 children and are an amazingly loving family.



However, neither Mum nor Amelia (age 18) were home. Just 2 weeks ago, Amelia was diagnosed with Leukaemia in the most advanced stage. She is having strong chemo treatment but the outcome is very unsure. The whole family would love to see a healing miracle and yet they have a wonderful peace and trust that God knows best and knows what He is doing. Amelia herself said that she doesn't mind what God chooses, she just wants her oldest brother, who is not a believer, to trust Jesus. She said she would gladly sacrifice her life for that to happen. I can't possibly convey every little detail I learned but know that I was inspired and challenged and convicted when I think of the comparably insignificant things that I worry about.

Laptop Lessons

My trusty Toshiba laptop for which I thank God decided to blow its transformer box and finding a replacement so far as proved futile. I've bought another box which we had to doctor to make it fit but the amperage is not right and it keeps overheating and cutting out. Not an ideal situation, but something that I must stay patient about and when I think of the Marianciuc Family, it is a very trivial problem.
