Friday night.

Down at the Sports Complex we were suddenly flooded with scores of young people wanting to play football. We had about 30-40 guys (and 2 girls) wanting to play football and about 20+ watching (mainly girls). I decided to put Grecia in charge. The guys respect him and he speaks their language. He picked a number of people to be captains and we played paper - scissors - rock to see who picked first and it was just like the school yard all over again. I managed to be the first to have a pick. So I picked Sergei (nickname Raps). He is a simple minded guy who was also drunk that night - no one was ever going to pick him. I then picked the two girls and a young bloke named Mesha. It was going to be a tough night. Valera (see last monthly) turned up late and joined our team once we realised Raps was under the weather. The fact that we managed to win one game caused great celebration.

Anyhow, partly through Grecia's influence we had 10 new people (mainly guys) come back to the Ministry Centre. We played a Jono version of "It's In The Bag" and no matter how many lollies i offered the lure of the unseen was always stronger, they always chose the bag. My devotion was based on Luke 14:25-33 and we had to consider counting the cost if we want to follow Jesus. Please pray that these young people will be caused to think this next week about God's claim on their lives. Valera was back again and smiling and acting as if he wouldn't miss it for anything. I get the impression he is really seriously looking into what we are all about. Please pray that he doesn't just see us but that he sees Jesus. That he comes face to face with Jesus, repents and desires to be a disciple of Jesus.

I have been given a real sense of burden to see young men desire to abandon themselves to Jesus and become strong men of God. This country desperately needs Godly men.
