I want my relationship with Jesus to grow deeper - more and more real and genuine. Please pray for me in this area.

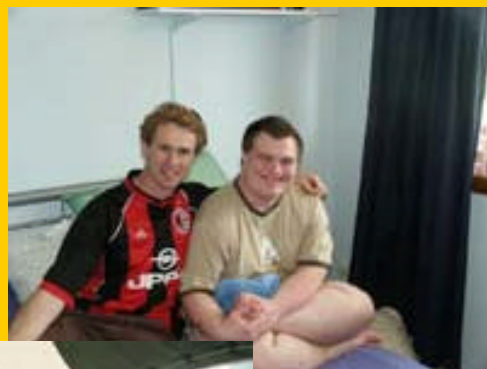
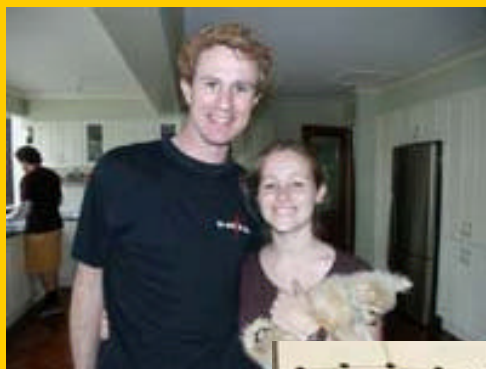
